Cross border at Niagara Falls

Cross the border into Ontario and take Falls Avenue to highway 420, also called Niagara Veterans Memorial Highway.

Follow 420 to the Q.E.W., which stands for Queen Elizabeth Way. Take the Q.E.W north to Hamilton. Just past Hamilton you go over a big bridge and then the Q.E.W. curves east towards Toronto.

Stay on the Q.E.W. Just past the town of Oakville you will take 403 north to highway 401. The 403 cutoff is right by the big Ford plant on the right side. Take the 403 to the 401.

Go east on highway 401 to highway 400. Head north on highway 400. You will drive all the way to the city of Barrie.

You will drive all the way to the city of Barrie. Just north of Barrie highway 400 ends. It splits into highway 69 and highway 11. Take

highway 11 north to North Bay. When you get to North Bay there is a tricky little zig-zag through town before Highway 11 heads north again. Follow the Highway 11 signs. The road will steer to the left when you come into town and then about 2 miles ahead you have to turn right. If you go by a McDonalds and then go up a big steep hill you are in the right place.

Then head north towards Marten River. When you approach the town of Marten River look for Highway 64 signs. Turn left on Highway 64 and then follow for about 5 miles. Our camp is on the right side. There is a sign.
